## **NAPA COUNTY DEPUTY SHERIFFS' ASSOCIATION ENDORSES RYAN GREGORY FOR SUPERVISOR**

**Napa, CA** – The Napa County Deputy Sheriffs' Association has endorsed Ryan Gregory for the 2<sup>nd</sup> District seat on the Napa County Board of Supervisors.

The Napa County Deputy Sheriffs' Association (DSA) represents Sergeants, Deputies, District Attorney Investigators and former law enforcement officers. The DSA is dedicated to serving Napa County and its cities, and their mission focuses on partnering with the community and providing quality law enforcement services through community interaction that emphasizes cooperation, professionalism, and ethical behavior.

Upon learning of the endorsement, Gregory said, "I am proud to have the support of the Napa County Deputy Sheriffs' Association, the latest testament in our ability to build broad coalitions who want a change in leadership for District 2. My great uncle was our Napa County Sheriff beginning in the 1960's, and I'm proud to continue his legacy of service alongside our revered law enforcement officials. I look forward to working with our law enforcement community to keep Napa County safe, and thank the DSA for their support and endorsement."

Ryan Gregory finished with 41.5% of the vote in the four-person June primary. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Supervisorial District encompasses much of western Napa, including parts of Browns Valley and downtown Napa, as well as unincorporated areas west of Napa stretching to the Sonoma-Napa County line.
